


Memorandum of Understanding Between

Patna University, Patna, Bihar
&

The National Federation of Societies for Fast Justice


1. The National Federation of Societies for Fast Justice, New Delhi is a federation of independently registered societies across the country that work for providing access to Justice to the marginalized peoples of India besides campaigning for timely Justice.
2. Patna University, established more than hundred years ago has contributed enormously in education of people of India. It is engaging in building a scholarly community that is committed to teaching, quality research, co-curricular and socially productive activities. The University is committed to contribute to the resurgence of inclusive development in Bihar. While the university is an accomplished knowledge Centre the Federation is engaged at the grass roots in inclusive development of the Country.
3. This MOU is aimed at cooperation of the two institutions for the benefit of both institutions and primarily for the benefit of the Society at large. It is agreed this is MOU that the following general forms of cooperation will be pursued:
 - a. Joint participation & Joint organizations of Conference /workshops/symposia.
 - b. Jointly designing & delivering short-term academic programs.
 - c. Providing field data & grass roots insight to students of the university that are engaged in research in Social Sciences, law, development & women studies.
 - d. Providing cases of marginalized communities to legal Aid Clinic of the faculty of Law.

- e. Providing opportunities for internship at P.G. and U.G. Level with particular focus on semester IV elective Basket.
 - f. Work in close cooperation with the Women Study Centre in Extension, Research, Documentation & Advocacy activities of the Centre.
 - g. Work in close cooperation with Computer science faculty to develop Systems/Software for use in social sector development programs/Schemes of the government or otherwise.
4. Each activity to be implemented under this agreement of cooperation shall be mutually discussed and agreed upon by both parties prior to the initiation of that activity. The financial implications of each activity will be discussed & agreed upon on a case by case basis. Any such agreements entered into, as outlined above, will form appendices to this Agreement of Cooperation. Each institution shall designate a liaison officer to develop and coordinate the specific activities agreed upon.
 5. This agreement becomes effective on the date of signature. It is valid for three (3) years with the understanding that either party may terminate the agreement with six (06) months notice in writing, unless an earlier termination is mutually agreed upon. Revisions or modifications may be proposed at any time, effective from the date of written agreement signed by both parties.
