POST-GRADUATE DIPLOMA IN YOGIC SCIENCES COURSE

- The maximum number of students to be admitted to the course shall be 60 (sixty)
- The minimum educational qualification required for admission to the course shall be Bachelor's degree in any faculty of Patna University or of any other University recognized by Patna University as equivalent there to.
- 3. Selection for admission to the course shall be made on the basis of marks secured by the candidate in the qualifying (graduation) examination. A weightage of 100 (one hundred) marks will be given to those candidates who have done a minimum of 4 (four) months' yoga course from an institute recognized by the UGC/
- 4. Admission shall be made strictly in order of merit.
- Reservation for candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC categories shall be provided as per reservation rules/ regulations prescribed by the government.
- Candidates falling next in the general merit list shall fill up seats left unfilled in any of the categories for reserved seats by reason of the fact that no eligible reserved candidate is available.
- Every candidate seeking admission to the course shall pay such fees as prescribed by the University. The fee may be changed from time to time with the prior approval of the Chancellor.
- 8. No applicant shall be admitted to the course who has not applied for admission within the notified time, or who on being selected for admission, does not get himself/herself enrolled the specified time, except when the delay has been condoned by the Vice-chancellor.
- No applicant shall be admitted to the course who in the opinion of the Vicechancellor should not be admitted in the best interest of the University.
- The Post-Graduate Diploma in Yogic Sciences shall be placed in the faculty of Science.

DRAFT REGULATIONS FOR POSTGRADUATE DIPLOMA IN YOGIC SCIENCES, PATNA UNIVERSITY

1. The Course:

This shall be a course of one year duration. It shall be conducted at the Patna University, Patna.

2. Number of Seats:

The number of seats for admission to the course shall be 60 (sixty).

3. Admission:

- (a) Candidates seeking admission to the course must be a graduate in arts, science, commerce or hold equivalent qualification of a recognized University/Institute.
- (b) Selection of candidates shall be made on the basis of marks obtained in the qualifying examination (graduation) as per the admission rules. Candidates having certificate in yogic studies shall be given weightage.

4. Fee Structure :



5. Teaching Schedule:

The duration of the course shall be one academic year. The course shall consist of four theory and two practical papers of 100 marks each. The course shall be specified in the syllabus and the Patna University shall conduct the examination in all the six papers on completion of the course.

6. Examination:

(a) Candidates admitted to the course, on completion of studies by attending at least 75 percent of the classes held and on payment of prescribed fees, shall be permitted to take the examination of the PG Diploma Course.

(b) The final examination of the course shall begin at least seven days after

the completion of the course period.

(c) The duration of examination of each theory paper shall be three hours and

that of a practical paper of four hours.

(d) Candidates, in order to pass the examination, must obtain 40 % in all the theory papers taken together and 50 % in the practical papers tken together. Among the successful candidates, those securing less than 60 % marks shall be placed in the Second Class. Candidates securing 60 % and above marks in aggregate shall be placed in the First Class.

(e) Every candidate who passes the examination shall receive a Diploma in the format approved by the Academic Council of the University.
