

### Academic Year 2020-21

Examination process in the University is not fully automated. The examination procedure involve the following steps –

Step- 1: Registration of the student - Online

Step- 2: Filling up the Examination Forms - Online

Step- 3: Evaluation of Answer sheet - Manual

Step- 4: Coding and Decoding of Answer sheet - Manual

Step- 5: Data Entry of Forms and Marks - Through computer

Step- 6: Preparation of Tabulation Register, Marks sheet & Provisional certificate – Through computer

Step- 7: Preparation of Degree Certificate - Manual/digital printing

We didn't purchase any ready made software for the result publication. All the related software is developed in-house by our regular permanent Employees.

The Master degree programmes and undergraduate vocational programmes are under CBCS, however the U.G. courses are still in yearly system. In yearly system in U.G. Course all the papers are of full 100 marks. In P.G. Course the theory paper exam was conducted by the university and practical by the respective department. However in Semester system each paper is divided as 70 marks of ESE (End Semester Exam) conducted by the University and 30 Marks of CIA (Continuous Internal Assessment) conducted by the respective Department. The introduction of CBCS improved the student performance since the academic session 2018.
