Patna University polls: Nomination papers go on sale, students excited



PATNA: Electioneering for the Patna University Students Union (PUSU) elections scheduled for November 19 picked up momentum with the sale of nomination forms beginning on Thursday. Aspirants for the various offices of the union were seen queuing up before the university counters right before 10 am to buy nomination papers selling at Rs 10 each. They had to state the name of posts for which they would be filing their nominations. The sale of nomination papers will continue up to 3 pm on Saturday. Students can file their

nomination papers between 10 am and 3 pm on November 7, 9 and 10 at Wheeler Senate House. Polling for the election of the five key office-bearers, including president, vicepresident, secretary, joint secretary and treasurer besides class representatives (councillors) would be held on November 19. The unit-wise number of councillors will be Patna Women's College (five), Magadh Mahila College (three), B N College (two), Patna College (two), Patna Science College (two), Vanijya Mahavidyalaya (one), Patna Law College (one), Women's Training College (one), Patna Training College (one), College of Arts and Crafts (one), faculty of social science (two), faculty of humanities (one), faculty of science (one), and faculties of commerce, law and education (one). There is one councillor for every 1000 students.

Representatives of different student organizations as well as the aspirants participated in a meeting convened by PU vicechancellor Girish Kumar Chaudhary at Wheeler Senate House on Thursday afternoon and learned the details of the entire election process. PU authorities, including pro-VC Ajay Kumar Singh, chief returning officer Khagendra Kumar, students' welfare dean Anil Kumar, proctor Rajneesh Kumar, and registrar Kamesh Kumar apprised the students with the model code of conduct, age limit for candidates, no arrear of academic year, and process of electioneering. The students also raised some queries about the grounds of rejection of one's candidature and clash of the schedule of some examinations with the election timing. They were all assured of sympathetic consideration of their grievances. They were also urged to remain disciplined and maintain peace on the campus during the entire conduct of elections.

Meanwhile, PU has requisitioned from the state election office 500 ballot boxes to be used on the polling day. It has also requested the district administration to sanction additional police forces for the university campus in the wake of PUSU elections. Police patrolling would be introduced around colleges, university departments and hostels right from the day of filing of nominations to the declaration of election results, said the students' welfare dean.
