High-speed internet link on Patna University campus soon



PATNA: The faculty members and scholars of Patna University (PU) will soon get the facility of high-speed internet connectivity on the campus. All the colleges, post-graduate departments and libraries will be linked with a network of high-speed internet. The information technology department of the Union government has already

sanctioned a sum of Rs 8.15 crore to the university for the purpose. A six-member team of the implementing agency, ERNET India, led by its additional director Arnay Srivastava, visited PU early this week and discussed the plan in detail with the university officials led by vicechancellor G K Chaudhary. The team members also made an on-the-spot survey of the sites to be connected with the high-speed internet. Congratulations! You have successfully cast your vote Login to view result Giving details of the project, PU IT Cell's professor- in-charge Birendra Prasad said that a sum of Rs 6.45 crore would be spent on the equipment and Rs 1.75 crore on networking. A 26,000 metre-long optical fibre would be laid underground in and around the campus to provide internet connectivity. In the first phase, the institutions and wings to be connected with high-speed internet will include PU administrative office, central library, guest house, Patna Science College, Patna College, Vanijya Mahavidyalaya, Darbhanga House complex, and central dispensary. Besides, the vocational courses building, advanced research centre (under construction) and all the hostels located between Patna College and Patna Science College would also be linked. In the second phase, the institutions to be provided high-speed internet connectivity would include Patna Law College, B N College, Magadh Mahila College, and Women's Training College, Prasad said.

PU students' welfare dean Anil Kumar said though the campus has already got free wi-fi connectivity under the 'Saat Nischaya' scheme of the state government and about 800 people are utilizing it daily on an average on the campus, its connectivity is so slow that many a time scholars face immense hardship in downloading the desired information. Under the new project, the internet speed would be enhanced from the present 20 MBPS to as high as 10 GBPS. As a result, the scholars would be able to download even larger files of documents or videos in a second with the high-speed internet connectivity, he said. Kumar added that the installation work is likely to be started soon and the entire project would be completed by March, 2023.

Patna University to hold entrance test for PG vocational courses on November 5 & 6



PATNA: Patna University (PU) will hold entrance tests for admission to its self-financing (vocational) courses at the post-graduation level in the current academic session (2022-23) on November 5 and 6. A detailed schedule indicating the time, date and centre of entrance tests has already been announced by the university. Since the

three-year LLB course has attracted the maximum number of applicants (2282) against only 120 seats, the entrance test for admission to this course would be held on November 6 at two centres, namely, Magadh Mahila College and B D Public School. The test will be held from 2.30 pm to 4 pm., said PU examination controller R K Mandal. The courses for which entrance tests will be held in the first shift (from 10.30 am) on November 5 at Magadh Mahila College centre include master of social work (MSW), postgraduate diploma in industrial safety management (PGDISM), MSc in biochemistry and LLM. The entrance test for admission to bachelor of library and information science (BLIS), master of library and information science (MLIS), master of computer applications (MCA), and MSc in environmental science and management courses will be held at the same centre in the second shift (from 2.30pm). Congratulations! You have successfully cast your vote Login to view result The entrance tests for admission to the MEd course and MSc in biotechnology course would be held at Magadh Mahila College centre in the morning shift (from 10.30 am) on November 6. The entrance test for admission to the four-year bachelor of fine arts (BFA) course and twoyear master of journalism and mass communications (MJMC) course will be held at Patna Science College centre in the first shift (from 10.30 am) on November 5. The institutions running these self-financing courses would hold personal interviews of candidates after the conduct of their entrance tests and the results would be announced after computing the marks obtained in the written test and personal interview, said PU students' welfare dean Anil Kumar.

It may be mentioned here that admission to all other regular (conventional) undergraduate and postgraduate courses has already been completed and the classes of the newly-admitted students have also started.
